Ø DAY UNITED STATES1 Quintessential Miami

Port: Miami Departure: 17:00 Arrival Method: DOCK

Welcome to Miami and the sweep of South Beach - backdrop to every iconic Miami movie, and forefront of Latin American culture. Stroll through pastel-hued geometric buildings in the art deco district, to graffiti mural masterpieces at Wynwood Walls. Watch Latino life unfold in Little Havana - the heartbeat of this great city - where walkup windows sell café cortadito, sweet sugarcane juice, hatuey beer and guava ice-cream. Watch passionate locals discuss politics, play dominoes and smoke cigars. Shimmy at a salsa class, shop designer boutiques and race marlin and sharks by speedboat. Then slow your pace to uncover rare and endangered species at the Everglades National Park outdoor oasis. You'll find the Miami dream is real – and it's not just Cuban heels that will give you a spring in your step.



Ø DAY U.S. VIRGIN ISLANDS 4 Charlotte Amalie Charms

Port: Charlotte Amalie (Saint Arriva Thomas) Arrival: 08:00 Depar

Arrival Method: DOCK

Departure: 17:00

Savour a fusion of heritage in sparkly St Thomas. Roam a flawless Capital teeming with local culture, smart boutiques, American hallmarks, streets bearing Danish names, and former hideouts for the notorious pirates of Blackbeard and Bluebeard. Climb up to historic landmarks, catch the cable car for serious views and savour the Frenchtown quarter famed for its restaurants. Ferry to scenic conservatory of St. John, float around diamond-sand beaches with limpid blue waters and venture on forested yomps through rugged hilltops. Dreamy Caribbean warmth soaked in Danish roots and American influence - this USVI is a curious culture clash with plenty of personality.



Ø DAY GUADELOUPE 5 La Belle Vie Point-à-Pitre

Port: Pointe-à-Pitre Arrival: 10:00 Arrival Method: DOCK Departure: 18:00

Pretty Point-à-Pitre flutters between the two wing-like islets of of Guadeloupe's butterfly-shaped island. Meander through the leafy Victory Square to lively markets and chic boutiques or explore the award-winning Memorial ACTe. Cross the bridge to Basse-Terre to explore rain forests, waterfalls, French fort ruins and sleepy La Grande Soufrière volcano. Or venture to the east island, Grand-Terre, to hit the multi-coloured beaches, summit sky-high Castle Point, then seek sanctuary in museums for Nobel-winning poet and diplomat, Alexis Léger for an afternoon of on-point pleasures.





DAY DOMINICA

6 Restorative Roseau

Port: Roseau Arrival: 09:00 Arrival Method: DOCK Departure: 21:00

Soak up the ultimate wellbeing experience at a real life "Nature Island." Oxygenate in lush rainforests, revive under waterfalls, convene in thermal sprint waters, and detox in volcanic mud baths. Trek Morne Trois Pintons National Park, a UNESCO jewel with the Mother Nature's rarest flora and fauna. Stir-up true Caribbean soul food; taste callaloo soup; sip spiced rum; and learn how herbs can heal. To cap it all, you can even snorkel in the bubbles of uber-healthy Champagne Reef.




DAY SAINT LUCIA7 Port Castries Glow

Port: Castries Arrival: 08:00

Arrival Method: DOCK Departure: 19:00

Wind your way through the romantic island of St Lucia. Hike up the majestic UNESCO-listed Pitons, wallow in a volcanic mud bath, lounge on black sand beaches, explore botanical gardens and venture into a tropical jungle scattered with banana, coconut and mango plantations. Choose between calm Caribbean or choppy Atlantic seas to skim through waters by catamaran, private boat or kayak. Refresh beneath a waterfall, watch gliding whales and enjoy freshly caught mahi mahi with local Piton beer. Or just relax into an inner glow of serenity as you unwind in this tranquil tropical isle.





Ø DAY GRENADA 8 Oh-so Spicy St. George's

Port: St. George's (Grenada) Arrival: 08:00

Arrival Method: DOCK Departure: 19:00

Nestled in the horseshoe of the caldera, with candy-coloured houses spilling down the hillsides to the water, this deep natural harbour is often considered the prettiest in the Caribbean. Wander the Georgian buildings of the Carenage, elegant masts swaying in the breeze, to market stalls brimming with tropical fruit and island spices, the colonial-era Fort George, the Catholic cathedral and Anglican church – painstakingly rebuilt after the 2004 hurricane – and the House of Chocolate, a shop, café and micro museum deliciously devoted to Grenada's cacao trade. From here, head to the mountainous and lush, jungly green interior, hike to the island's famed falls and cool off beneath the cascade, or travel to the quieter north on a spice journey, nutmeg scenting the air.




Ø DAY SAINT VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES 9 Saint Vincent and the Grenadines

Port: Kingstown Arrival: 09:00 Arrival Method: TENDER Departure: 18:00

Wander into the quiet laid-back charm of historical St Vincent. Explore Fort Charlotte, the ancient Botanic Gardens - sanctuary to the endangered Amazon parrot - and hike the lush Vermont Valley for views of banana farms and rainforests. Feel the wind in your sails aboard a schooner or dip in to race seahorses, spot barracuda and admire leaping sea frogs. Watch welcoming Vincentians gently fry jackfruit and lace fruit punch with rum in this sultry tropical wonderland. And with such a backdrop, it's easy to understand why The Pirates of the Caribbean movie was shot here.





Day Barbados Balmy Bridgetown

Gently breeze into the vibrant capital of Barbados. Steeped in fascinating history, with architecture to match, uncover the wonderfully laid-back West Indian ambiance. Embrace the slow Bajan rhythm of this welcoming island; surf, snorkel and try spotting turtles in balmy azure waters. Explore subterranean Harrison's Cave, Jacobean St Nicholas Abbey and zipline high above bountiful tropical flora. Then return to restore on pastel pink sands at palm-studded beaches, where you'll discover cocktail hour is endless, and measures of rum are copious.



DAY SAINT VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES Bequia Breeze

Summon your inner Robinson Crusoe on remote Bequia. Secret lagoons. Castaway picnics. Warm waters in shades of blue that beg to be snorkelled through. Stake your flag in the sweet Bequia breeze just as the Union Jack did for almost 200 years. Usher in deep tranquillity on lovely Princess Margaret Beach. Ascend Mount Peggy with sunny views of St. Vincent. Stoll Belmont Boardwalk to Margret Beach for hand-whittled mahogany boat models then prowl the concrete catwalk that runs along Port Elizabeth for home-churned nutmeg ice cream. Support a sterling turtle sanctuary protecting the rare hawksbill or ferry to nearby Mustique, the favourite holiday romp for Prince William and Kate Middleton.





DAY TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO 12 Port of Spain: Caribbean Melting Pot

Few Caribbean nations are as rich as Trinidad and Tobago, where indigenous culture, European architecture, Indian heritage and Afro-Caribbean spirit merge in a sensory whirlwind. Port of Spain sprawls from the green expanse of Queen's Park Savannah, where locals stroll in the shade of pink poui trees, spice-scented aromas drift through the air and a calypso soundtrack sets the rhythm for laid-back living. Trace the island's history in architectural treasures like the gothic turrets of Stollmeyer's Castle and the Greco-Roman outline of Whitehall. Beyond the city, spot scarlet ibis swooping through the mangroves in Caroni Swamp, take in the Gulf of Praia from Fort George and explore the mountainous Northern Range.




[®] DAY MARTINIQUE13 Joie de Vivre of Fort-de-France

Follow the French flag waving over the hulking fortress that gave the city its name then dive into the island's Afro-French-West Indies culture. Green is the island's colour for sustainability, spicy is its flavour, and Creole is its soul. This "island of flowers" lives up to her name as one of the world's 35 biodiversity hotspots. Hike beside waterfalls, ponder the flying buttresses at Cathédrale St-Louis, and savour cocoa farms, local rum, and artisan sorbet in the shade of one of the island's enchanting gardens.






MONTSERRAT DAY Follow the Forces of Nature in Little 14 Bay

Port: Little Bay Arrival: 08:00

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Arrival Method: DOCK Departure: 18:00

Diminutive in stature but big on ambition, Little Bay is a testament to the resilience of Montserrat, where the 1997 eruption of Soufrière Hills Volcano turned fairy-tale capital Plymouth to ash. Today, a new city rises amid the emerald folds and transcendent beaches of the northern coast, where coral gardens bloom in Caribbean currents and humpback whales weave between the waves. Jungle hikes and kayaking adventures are rewarded with sublime sunsets in tropical beach bars that pay homage to the island's musical legacy. Venture to the ruins of Plymouth and stand humbled before skeletal buildings submerged in a torrent of volcanic debris, then discover the forces of nature at the Montserrat Volcano Observatory for up-close views of the monstrous crater.



♥ DAY VIRGIN ISLANDS, BRITISH Turn It Up In Tortola 15

A tropical utopia with soaring peaks for climbing, waves for surfing, wrecks for snorkelling, and cocktails with locally sourced rum. All around Road Town, the capital of the British Virgin Islands, are streets lined with brightly coloured buildings built during the days of colonial Dutch and British rule. Check out Pusser's Painkiller Bar for a namesake punch before venturing into the humid embrace of the highcanopied forest of Sage Mountain. Beyond are adventures at every turn; zip-line through treetops; dive coral-laden lagoons, explore jungles with 4x4's, or lounge on countless postcard-perfect beaches. And, since this is the so-called "sailing capital of the Caribbean," don't miss catching a catamaran navigating to a scattering of uninhabited islands.
