

6 Sand Swept Îles de la Madeleine

Port: Iles de la Madeleine Arrival Method: TENDER
Arrival: 08:00 Departure: 14:00

A tiny archipelago of eight islands, Îles de la Madeleine lives up to its name in grace and beauty. This liliputin piece of the Quebec Province moves with a distinct Arcadian French accent. Dainty and delightful, enjoy almost 320 km (200 mi) of beach, ever-changing sandscapes, coquettish villages, red sandstone cliffs, and a quirky joie de vivre. Wend through Cap aux Meules, the commercial heart of the isles then hike Parc des Buck or cycle the coast on trails that lead to soulsoothing views. Retreat to the forest on Havre Aubert Island; dig your toes in the sand at Dune-du-Nord beach, which was named one of Canada's top beaches; then find a bistro in Îles de Grande Entrée, designated as Quebec's Lobster Capital, for the best ruby reds in the world.

7 Havre-Saint-Pierre Reserve

Port: Havre-Saint-Pierre Arrival Method: DOCK Arrival: 09:00 Departure: 18:00

Recharge on an escape to the Mingan Archipelago National Park. Visit historical sites amid an array of protected islands wrapped in seasculpted limestone. Discover impressive fossils on Niapiskau Island and wind your way through a rich array of flora and fauna on Quarry Island. Wander inland to the eco-friendly boreal forest where you'll uncover impressive ancient limestone monuments. Tread quietly across pebble strewn beaches and striking coastal scenery to watch playful seals below soaring seabirds and meet the local Innu people to immerse in thousand-year culture.




8 Baie-Comeau Vistas
